Kingdom Sports Center staff would like to update our coaches, players and parents on a few items today. We will go over these together today in hopes that we can work together to help our children grow and have a fun, safe atmosphere inside Kingdom Sports Center.

1. Thank you for your support of Kingdom Sports Center. As we continue our lawsuit with the state of Ohio, we are thankful for your support during one of the most important times in our country's history.
2. RESEPECT: the officials, the facility and each other. Today, more than ever, we need to show respect towards one another. With reports of players, coaches and parents using foul language, a few ejections, and foul language to our staff, we need to make sure you understand our policies to help keep our facility a safe environment for your children.

 - c. We will be monitoring games to ensure quality throughout our facility
 - d. If you experience any unruly fans, coaches or spectators, please email contact@kingdomsportscenter.com and we can take further action
 - e. We will be asking the coach to take responsibility for their players and parents... Teams that do not comply with our policies will have their games removed and a possible complete suspension of season without refund.
 - f. Please make sure you encourage your players to clean up your players bench area: this is a courtesy and a respectful action to help leave your bench cleaner than when you got there.
3. DIVISION GENDER RULES
 - a. Our leagues are designed to allow for maximum competitiveness. We believe in a fair league by gender. We do not allow COED DIVISIONS for our league or tournaments in any basketball event at Kingdom Sports Center: unless advertised as such.
 - b. Any team violating this will have an immediate forfeit and further action could result in suspension of the team for the remainder of the season.
4. SUPERBOWL SUNDAY: We do have games on SuperBowl Sunday. With having 10 weeks to get 10 games played, we do not have the luxury of taking off this weekend. Schedules have been available since December and have only changed if teams have had to cancel their games. We ask that you do the following
 - a. Please make sure your team has enough to play. We are asking that if you do not have enough to play your superbowl game:
 - i. Email contact@kingdomsportscenter.com to let us know that you are canceling your game. Please start to reach out now to confirm either way
 - ii. Deadline to cancel your game is Feb 2nd (Tuesday)

- iii. Games that are canceled for your team or the opposing team will not be made up. We are completely sold out at 211 teams with not an hour to spare on the weekends and Wednesday nights.

5. END OF SEASON TOURNAMENT:

- a. The season ending tournament will be played for grades 2nd – 8th grade
- b. Games will be played Friday – Sunday (Feb. 26,27,28)
- c. 1 Game Pool Play with Bracket play followed
- d. Depending on numbers, we will have a High Competitive and Low Competitive divisions.
- e. We need confirmation on your teams entry
- f. Deadline to enter tournament is Feb. 18th (Thursday)
- g. Requests can be granted for Friday and Saturday Only. No Sunday Requests available during bracket play. If you cannot play due to another league or event, we need to know by Feb 18th to remove your team. If we do not hear from your team, they will be automatically removed from the Season Ending Tournament
