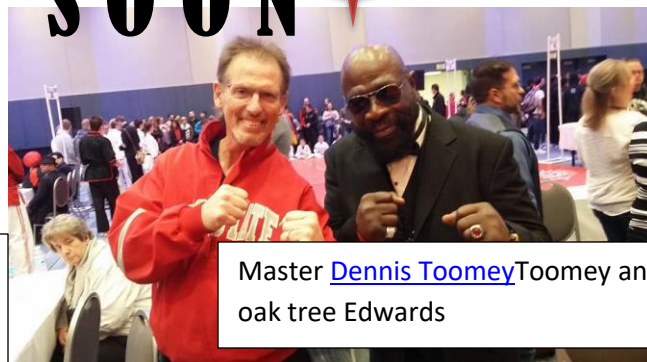

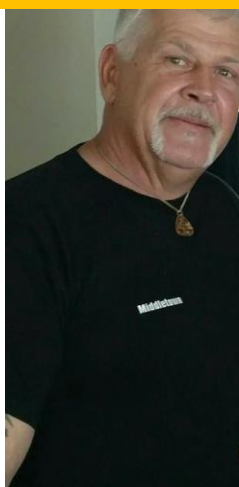


Oak tree Demetrius Edwards a world Champion fighter and Master Hayes also a world Champion fighter.

Master Whitt started studying Martial Arts at the age of 9 and has studied and mastered many different art forms for the past 55 years.

Master Whitt specializes in working with children and was awarded the **Best Youth Instructor** in the world in 2016 by the International Kwanmukan Association.

Many of **Master Whitt's** students have won Start Championships and have also competed Internationally in the Pan Am Games.

Master Whitt's students have also competed in the Miami Valley Tournament Association. His students started competing in 2014 through 2019 in the Miami Valley Tournament Association.
